/ MAGSPYD IS A MODIFICATION OF MAGSPY THAT PROVIDES THE ABILITY TO LOOK AT ANY LENGTH TAPE, AND TO VIEW THE UNPACKED ASCII GENERATED BY THE DIAL-MS ASSEMBLER WITH A LISTAPE INSTRUCTION. IT ALLOWS CONVENIENT USE OF THE TELETYPE TO RESTART THE PROGRAM, REWIND THE TAPE, GO TO DIAL, OR TO DISPLAY A HELP FRAME TO EXPLAINING THE SENSE SWITCH OPTIONS. IT INCLUDES AN A/D KNOB TO CONTROL OF THE NUMBER OF LINES DISPLAYED ON THE SCREEN AND A SENSE SWITCH OPTION TO STOP THE MOVEMENT OF THE DISPLAY. IT ALSO CONTAINS THE OCTAL DISPLAY AND LARGE/SMALL WAVEFORM OPTIONS OF EARLIER MODIFICATIONS.

THIS MODIFICATION USES EXTENDED ADDRESSING TO PERMIT THE VIEWING OF LINC TAPES OF ANY LENGTH. AT PRESENT IT IS SET TO VIEW TAPES WITH A LENGTH OF 1600(8) BLOCKS (SEE PRECAUTION FOR SHORTER TAPES). WHEN THE END LIMITS ARE REACHED THE DISPLAY SIMPLY STOPS MOVING AND WAITS FOR A REVERSAL OF KNOB 6 TO BACK IT UP.

## SENSE SWITCHES

UP FOR ASCII DISPLA!, DOWN FOR WAVEFORM.

- 1 UP FOR SMALL SIZE NUMBERS AND LETTERS, DOWN FOR LARGE SIZE.
- 2 UP FOR ASCII CHARACTERS, DOWN FOR OCTAL.
- 3 UP FOR PACKED ASCII, DOWN FOR UNPACKED ASCII AS GENERATED BY THE LISTAPE INSTRUCTION.
- 4 UP FOR MOVEABLE DISPLAY, DOWN TO STOP THE DISPLAY MOVEMENT.
- 5 UP FOR SMALL WAVEFORMS COMPATIBLE WITH THE PDP-12 A/D CONVERTOR, DOWN FOR THE LARGE WAVEFORMS OF THE REGULAR MAGSPY.
