ABSTRACT: A modified Blackjack game written in FOCAL. The game contains standard Blackjack payoffs as well as a "double down option" on hands of 10 or 11.

OPERATION: The game is initiated by typing "GO". The carriage return terminates all lines. In response to the questions asked by the computer, the operator should type a "1" for yes and a "2" for no.

After asking for a bet the program deals two cards to the player and one card to the dealer. It then asks if you "Want a hit?". The player may hit the hand as many times as he desires or until the sum of his cards exceeds 21.

If the sum of the player's first two cards equals 10 or 11, the program will ask "Double down option". This is to be answered yes (1) or no (2) at the player's option. If the answer is yes the program will deal out the dealer's hand, then give one card to the player and make its win decision.

If the sum of the player's first two cards is 21, the program will type "Blackjack!" and make its payoff immediately.

RESTRICTIONS: The "A" (ACE) always has the value 11 in this game. There is a 1 which is also played. If the player's first two cards are both "A" the program will type out "Impossible Hand" and deal two new cards to the player. Since the game is played in essentially a "sampling with replacement" mode (unlike a true card game) the presence of only one value for the "A" makes little difference. In addition, this type of sampling allows for the possibility of, say, 6 tens in the same hand. These characteristics tend to balance, however, such that the probability of a win or loss is approximately equal.

SPECIAL OPERATION: The following modifications should be made to FOCAL (DEC-08-AJAD-PB) for this program:
